** **For the Independent Victoria BC Excursion:** Guests are responsible for their own transportation to/from the Clipper. The Seattle Clipper dock at Pier 69 is a 5-7 minute cab ride from downtown Seattle hotels. Guests are required to arrive at the Victoria Clipper Dock one hour prior to departure for check in.

** **Canadian Tour Restrictions:** Please note that proof of US citizenship and a US passport are required when you are leaving and entering the country. A picture driver's license alone is not considered proper identification unless accompanied with the above documentation.
